Changing Traction Tyres



Slide a small flat-bladed screwdriver under the old tyre as shown. Slide the screwdriver round the wheel, levering the tyre over the edge until it is removed.

Make sure the tyre groove is clean before fitting the new tyre.

Place the new tyre over the wheel groove and hold it in place at one point with the thumb of one hand. With the other hand slip the screwdriver under the tyre. Slide the screwdriver round the wheel, levering the new tyre into place as it goes. Check that the tyre is properly seated.

N.B: Some tyres are stamped from flat Neoprene sheet and look like washers. Others look like square section "O" rings. The method of fitting is just the same. The flat ones will turn and lay in the groove as they are eased over the wheel rim.
